Mono Lake Ranger District

Roads Closed: Tioga Pass and Saddlebag Lake Rds., Sonora Pass, Monitor Pass.

Roads are open: Bodie (Highway 270), Lundy Canyon, June Lake Loop (Hwy 158), Panum Crater, Parker Lake, South Tufa, Hwy 120 E.

Campground closed **for the season**: Aspen Grove, Big Springs, Bloody Canyon Trailhead CG, Big Bend, Upper Deadman, Lower Deadman, Ellery Lake, Glass Creek, Gull Lake, Hartley Springs, Junction, June Lake, Lower Lee Vining, Lundy Canyon (county), Moraine, Oh Ridge, Obsidian Flat Group, Reversed Creek, Silver Lake, Saddlebag Lake, Saddlebag Trailhead Group Camp, Sawmill Walk-in, Tioga Lake.

The Mono Basin Visitor Center is in winter hours. The visitor center will be open Thursday through Monday, 9:00 am to 4:30 pm and closed on Tuesdays and Wednesdays. It will be closed the day after Thanksgiving. The visitor center will close for the season on December 1st and re-open in April of 2016.

Mammoth Ranger District

Roads open: Convict Lake, Hot Creek Hatchery, Inyo Craters, Laurel Canyon (snow level 8,000 ft.), Mammoth Creek, Mammoth Scenic Loop, San Joaquin Trail, Sherwin Creek.

Road Closed: Devils Postpile National Monument, Reds Meadow, Lakes Basin, Old Mammoth Rd to Lakes Basin.

Convict Lake Road Reconstruction: Road near the lake is closed while the railing is completed.

Campgrounds open: Mammoth Mtn. RV Park (Private).

Campgrounds closed **for the season**: Agnew Meadows, Agnew Meadows Group, Agnew Meadows Horse Campground, Brown's Owens River (private), Coldwater, Convict Lake, Crowley Lake (BLM), Devils Postpile (NPS), Lake George, Lake Mary, Minaret Falls, Old Shady Rest, New Shady Rest, Pine City, Pine Glen Family/Group, Pumice Flat, Pumice Flat Group, Reds Meadow, Sherwin Creek, Twin Lakes, Upper Soda Springs.

Devils Postpile Ranger Station is closed.

The Mammoth Welcome Center is open 8:00 am to 5:00 pm daily

White Mountain Ranger District

CARMA restoration work is continuing. The final grading and road decommissioning and narrowing is occurring now. They are hauling non-native material furiously from the site while the weather is good.

It is a very active construction site. The contractors will be there through the Thanksgiving holiday, and beyond as long as the weather holds. Some forest system roads may be impassable, or with substantial delays, while they are actively restoring roads to original width.

Roads open: Hwy 168 West (to Lake Sabrina), North Lake, White Mt. Rd. to Sierra View, Wyman Canyon Rd., Big Pine Canyon Rd, Rock Creek Road (icy conditions near the lake).

Roads Closed: White Mt Rd. is closed beyond the Schulman Grove Visitor Center.

Campgrounds open: Bitterbrush and Holiday are opened under winter operations--no water, no camp host, no trash service, Goodale (BLM), Grandview (no water, no trash service, firewood is limited), Pleasant Valley Pit.

Campgrounds closed: Big Meadow, Iris Meadow, East Fork, French Camp, Rock Creek Lake, Mosquito Flat Backpacker, Aspen Group Camp, Tuff, McGee Creek, Pine Grove, Big Trees, Bishop Park, Bishop Park Group Camp, Four Jeffrey, Forks, Mountain Glen, North Lake, Sabrina, Intake 2 Walk-in, Intake 2, Table Mountain, Willow, Horton Lake (BLM) Big Pine Creek, Sage Flat, Upper Sage Flat, Clyde Glacier Group Camp, Palisade Glacier Group Camp, Group Camp Ferguson, Group Camp Nelson, Group Camp Noren.

The Ancient Bristlecone Pine Forest Visitor Center is closed for the season.

The White Mountain Ranger Station Visitor Center's winter hours are Monday to Friday, 8:00am to 12:00pm, 1:00 pm to 4:30pm. Closed federal holidays.

Mt Whitney Ranger District:

Road Closed: Horseshoe Meadow

Roads open: Foothill Rd., Division Creek Rd., Haiwee Canyon Rd. (flood damage), Rd., Mazourka Canyon Rd., Onion Valley Rd., Sage Flat Rd., Whitney Portal Rd.

Campgrounds open: Boulder Creek RV Resort (Private), Diaz Lake (County), Independence Creek (County), Portagee Joe (County).

Campgrounds closed: Cottonwood Lakes/ Pass Trailhead, Horseshoe Meadow Equestrian, Onion Valley Whitney Portal, Whitney Portal Trailhead, Upper Gray Meadow.

Starting 11/1: Lower Gray Meadow and Lone Pine (upper loop) campgrounds opened under winter operations--no water, no camp host, no trash service. Tuttle Creek (BLM) south section closed, 28 sites open for the winter.
