Bankhead National Forest

Sipsey Wilderness “Big Tree”

Fire - Oct. 19, 2015

A wildfire has temporarily closed selected trails because of a wildland fire that is currently located in the Sipsey Wilderness, Bankhead National Forest.

Until further notice the following trails will remain closed: 209 Sipsey River, 224 Bunyan Hill Wagon Trail/Road, 204 Bee Branch and 206 White Oak.

The Forest Service is asking wilderness visitors to limit parking at Braziel Creek and Borden Creek trailheads.

Open trails are the Owl Creek Non-Motorized Trail System and Sipsey Wilderness Trails, 208 Thompson to Gum Pond, 223 Gum Pond Road, 202 Randolph, 201 Rippey, 203 Lookout, 207 Braziel, 200 Borden and 210 Mitchell Ridge.
