PROHIBITED ACTS • ORDER NO. 95-01 AFFECTING FISH CREEK WILDLIFE OBSERVATION AREA JUNE 1 – SEPTEMBER 30

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), each of the following is prohibited within the Fish Creek Wildlife Observation Area, Tongass National Forest, from June 1 through September 30 of each year. A map of the Fish Creek Wildlife Observation Area is attached and made part of this Order (Exhibit A).

SPECIAL CLOSURES

1. It is prohibited to go into or be upon any area which is closed for the protection of public health or safety. 36 CFR 261.53(e)
 - Fish Creek stream banks and channel, as indicated on the attached map.

FOREST DEVELOPMENT ROADS

2. Using any type of vehicle prohibited by the Order. 36 CFR 261.54(a)
 - Operating any motorized vehicle on the Fish Creek Dike Road between the hours of 6:00 PM and 10:00 PM.
3. Operating a vehicle in violation of the speed, load, weight, height, length, width, or other limitations specified in the Order. 36 CFR 261.54(d)
 - Operating any vehicle in excess of twenty miles per hour (20 MPH).

OCCUPANCY AND USE


4. Camping. 36 CFR 261.58(e)
5. Parking or leaving a vehicle in violation of posted instructions. 36 CFR 261.58(g)
6. Possessing or storing any food or refuse, as specified in the Order. 36 CFR 261.58(cc)
 - Possessing or storing any food in an exposed condition.
 - Possessing any food that is being cooked or that is being prepared for cooking.

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), each of the following are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission. 36 CFR 261.50(e)(1)
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty. 36 CFR 261.50(e)(4)
3. Employees of any Federal or State agency, while engaged in biological, hydrological, or geological projects or studies. 36 CFR 261.50(e)(6)

These Prohibitions are in addition to the General Prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A. This Order may be made more restrictive by temporary Orders issued by the Regional Forester or the Forest Supervisor as needed to promote public safety, and to protect public property and resources.



