

The Eldorado National Forest is soliciting competitive offers for the Caesar Fire Salvage Stewardship Reoffer #2. Caesar Fire Salvage Stewardship Reoffer #2 is located within T.13.N., R.13.E., T.13.N., R.14.E., T.4N., R.13. E., T.14.N., R.14.E., M.D.B.&M. Sealed – “Best Value” offers will be received at the Forest Supervisor's Office at 10:00 A.M. local time on Tuesday, October 27, 2015 for an estimated 19,573 MBF of sawtimber marked or otherwise designated for cutting on 1374 acres and three Mandatory stewardship projects and four Optional stewardship projects. The Mandatory Project #1 is Biomass Cutting and Removal – Conventional Harvest Units on 744 acres; #2 Water Tower Delivery and Installation and #3 Water Tower. The Optional stewardship Project #4 is Machine Piling by the Hour; #5 Grapple Piling by the Hour; #6 Biomass Cutting and Removal – Non-harvest Units on 33 acres and #7 is Biomass Cutting and Removal – Conventional Harvest Units on 212 acres. This project also includes an unestimated volume of Timber Subject to Agreement on approximately 393 acres of skyline harvest units. Sale contains specified roads with an estimated public works construction cost of \$183,334.14. Bidders qualifying as small business concerns under the Small Business Act may, when submitting a bid, elect for the Forest Service to build permanent roads. Additional information concerning this option is in the prospectus. The Forest Service will evaluate competitive offers submitted by offerors who present a price offer and technical proposal according to the information found under the section in the offer titled “Instructions to Offerors.” Evaluation factors for this project are technical approach, capability and past performance, utilization of local workforce, and price. One award will be made to the offeror whose proposal is technically acceptable and whose technical/price relationship is the “best value” to the Government.
