

ORDER No. **15-26**
SEQUOIA NATIONAL FOREST
HUME LAKE RANGER DISTRICT
ROUGH FIRE CLOSURE

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), and to provide for public safety, the following acts are prohibited within the Hume Lake Ranger District of the Sequoia National Forest. This Order is effective from on October 23, 2015, until the Rough Fire is declared out.

1. Going into or being upon National Forest System lands within the Rough Fire Closure Area, as described in Exhibit A and shown on the attached map. 36 CFR 261.52(e).
2. Being on any National Forest System road listed below and shown on the attached map:
 - a. Any National Forest System road within the Rough Fire Closure Area;
 - b. Cherry Gap Road (Forest Road No. 13S77);
 - c. Indian Basin Road (Forest Road No. 13S48);
 - d. Huckleberry Road (Forest Road No. 13S02) from its intersection with Park Ridge Road (Forest Road No. 13S52) then northwest for approximately 1.8 miles to its intersection with Cherry Gap Road.

36 CFR 261.54(e).

3. Being on any National Forest System trail within the Rough Fire Closure Area, as shown on the attached map. 36 CFR 261.55(a).


Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of any official duty.
2. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR 261, Subpart A.

A violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571, and 3581.



The Rough Fire Closure Area begins at the intersection of the boundary of the Sequoia National Forest and the boundary of Kings Canyon National Park in Section 21, Township 12 South, Range 30 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian, then continues south approximately 20 miles along the forest boundary to its intersection with the Jennie Lakes Wilderness boundary in Section 34, Township 14 South, Range 29 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian, then continues north approximately 4.1 miles along the Jennie Lakes Wilderness boundary to its intersection with Shell Mountain Road (Forest Road No. 14S03), then continues west approximately 1.3 miles along Shell Mountain Road to its intersection with Big Meadow Creek Road (Forest Road No. 14S14), then continues west approximately 2.2 miles along Big Meadow Creek Road to its intersection with Horse Corral Road (Forest Road No. 14S11), then continues west approximately 1.9 miles along Horse Corral Road to its intersection with the Generals Highway, then continues west approximately 3.2 miles along Generals Highway to its intersection with Tenmile Road (Forest Road No. 13S09) in Section 11, Township 14 South, Range 28 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian, then continues north approximately 8.4 miles along Tenmile Road to its intersection with Sandy Cove Road (Forest Road No. 13S06) in Section 23, Township 13 South, Range 28 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian, then continues north approximately 1.3 miles along Sandy Cove Road to its intersection with Lakeshore Station Road (Forest Road No. 13S24), in Section 14, Township 13 South, Range 28 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian, then continues west approximately .5 miles along Lakeshore Station Road to its intersection with Tenmile Road in Section 14, Township 13 South, Range 28 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian then continues north approximately 3.1 miles along Tenmile Road to its intersection with the Highway 180 in Section 9, Township 13 South, Range 28 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian, then continues south approximately 4.7 miles along Highway 180 to its intersection with the Kings Canyon National Park Boundary in Section 29, Township 13 South, Range 28 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian, then continues southwest approximately 5 miles along the Sequoia National Forest boundary to its intersection with Highway 180 in Section 11, Township 14 South, Range 27 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian, then continues northwest approximately 7.5 miles along Highway 180 to its intersection with the Sequoia National Forest boundary in Section 32, Township 13 South, Range 27 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian, then continues along the Sequoia National Forest boundary back to the starting point, as shown on the attached map. 36 CFR 261.52(e).
