Church Creek Trail #871	8/26/2015	Hiking, Trail Maintenance	I like the on-line trail register format. It's easy to use and apparently can be used at any time after the trail hike. We do have a separate format to use to report trail maintenance projects, but I didn't want to pass up the opportunity to try it out.
Mt. Ellinor from upper trailhead	8/27/2015	Hiking	Sunny, warm and dry day. Trail in very good condition and busy for a Thursday. Visibility good. Startling to see wildfire smoke from eastern WA settling over the Puget Sound basin. No goat encounters at all. However the chipmunks at the summit are VERY habituated to people to the point of harassment. Monks jumped on my thigh and my pack despite my attempts to shoo them away with boot and trekking pole. What can be done to educate those new to hiking to not feed wildlife, including cute chipmunks? It seems a sign at the trailhead about this is as important as a sign about goats. Thanks for considering this.
Murhut Falls	9/5/2015	Hiking	Beautiful trail and falls.
Upper Dungeness	9/9/2015	Hiking, Camping	Went to Royal Lake. Upper Dungeness trail in excellent condition. Three down trees on Royal Lake trail - not passable to stock.
Mildred Lake	9/11/2015	Hiking, Camping	Challenging trail but there was flagging to help keep us on the trail and that was super helpful

Slab Camp Trail #838	9/19/2015	Hiking, Camping	We enjoyed the hike down to Gray Wolf River, camping near the junction with the Gray Wolf River Trail. Hiked up to Olympic National Park boundary the next day.
Elk Lake/ Jefferson Ridge	9/19/2015	Hiking, Other	The trail from Lower Elk Lake TH to the road was awesome with what looked like very recent trail maintenance. Then we walked the road until the Jefferson Ridge picking up a little trash along the way. The view from the former lookout is not as good as the view from .25 from the lookout. No one on the trail or the road as we were hiking. Found some chanterelles but they are just starting to come in.
Duckabush	9/26/2015	Hiking	Trees down near five mile
Putvin Trail	9/27/2015	Hiking	Trail was in excellent condition. Weather conditions were excellent. Small downed trees across trail, no other obstacles or issues.
Duckabush	9/21/2015	Hiking	Campsites were generally well-marked and well-maintained. Pit toilet at Upper Duckabush was in need of repair and very full. Pit toilet at Marmot Lake was also full. The trail was generally in good shape. There were at least 36 large downed trees to climb over or crawl under between Ten mile camp and the trail head. We saw elk herds almost every day as we hiked up to Marmot Lake and vicinity. All in all a beautiful hike and a great experience!
Putvin Trail	9/29/2015	Hiking	Hiked to Lake of the Angels on a glorious fall day. Trail is very steep and rough, requiring some hand assist climbing. Saw lots of songbirds, a few grouse, one deer and one group of five hikers. Enjoyed seeing so many fish crowding into inlet areas, presumably to spawn?
Mt Zion	9/19/2015	Hiking	Easy Hike, excellent views.
Murhut Falls	10/6/2015	Hiking	Trail very well groomed, nice and wide, an easy walk, gorgeous falls as a reward! One of the nicest trails we've taken. A suggestion for ALL trails is to give the hiker the length of the trail. We'd never heard of this trail, just out exploring back roads, so didn't have any info. We had our dogs leashed, and were glad, because the falls viewing area could be risky for both humans and dogs, where people have apparently climbed down.
Slab Camp Creek Trail	10/6/2015	Hiking	2 down trees on the other side of the river heading up the Gray Wolf trail.
Upper Dungeness	10/8/2015	Hiking, Other	Only hiked to the forks. The trail was fine to there.

There was previously a log over the trail at about 1200' but it was broken and now only partially blocks the trail - easy to get around for people but may cause problems for stock. Made it to the top in about an hour and good views at about 2pm. Started to cloud up by 3.

Mt Walker	10/16/2015	Hiking	beautiful warm day for October. The Gray Jays were plentiful at the old lookout. Bring plenty of snacks. By the way, there are 24 direction changes (or Switchback like features) in that steep trail. Bring plenty of water, too. There is a new downed tree over the trail about 3/4 of the way up. Not a big one.
slab camp	10/17/2015	Hiking	Good trail head access and parking. Trail is in very good condition to the Greywolf R. Trail signs at junction with the Lower Greywolf Trail near Camp Tony need to be corrected/ moved.
