



# FLAGSTAFF FIRE

**Final Update October 30, 2015**

- Flagstaff Fire, Salt Lake Ranger District, reported 10/14/15 lightning caused.
- Located 1 mile north of flagstaff peak and 2 miles up days fork drainage from Spruces campground up big Cottonwood Canyon.
- The fire is 0.7acre
- This lightning-caused fire is a natural part of the forest renewal process, and is being managed to improve big game forage, reduce hazardous fuels, and improve forest health, without posing undue risk to people or property.
- Forest personnel declared the fire out October 30, 2015
