

## PASS INFORMATION

There is now a forest-wide pass available.

Passes are honored across the Uinta-Wasatch-Cache National Forest. If you want to help support the area where you recreate, consider buying a pass from a local [Ranger District Office](#) or the [Uinta-Wasatch-Cache National Forest Headquarters](#).

Uinta-Wasatch-Cache **3 – Day Pass** - \$10.00

Uinta-Wasatch-Cache **7 - Day Pass**- \$20.00

Uinta-Wasatch-Cache **Annual Pass**- \$60.00



**“America the Beautiful” National Parks and Federal Lands Passes** are honored at recreation sites across the Uinta-Wasatch-Cache National Forest. (Not valid at Mill Creek Canyon)

Interagency Annual Pass- \$80

Interagency Senior Annual Pass- \$20 (U.S. Citizens or permanent residents 62 years or older)

Interagency Senior Lifetime Pass- \$80 (U.S. Citizens or permanent residents 62 years or older)

Interagency Military Annual Pass- Free (U.S. active-duty personnel /dependents)

Interagency Military Lifetime- Free (U.S. Veterans/Gold Star Families)

Interagency Access Pass- Free (U.S. Citizens or permanent residents who have been medically determined to have a permanent disability that severely limits one or more major life activities)

Interagency 4th Grade Pass- Free with voucher



### Mill Creek Canyon

- \$5.00/daily per car
- \$3.00/senior
- \$50.00/yearly pass
- \$30.00/yearly senior pass

**Fees are paid when you leave the canyon.** Yearly passes can be purchased at the fee booth at the mouth of Mill Creek Canyon or from the Salt Lake County Recreation/Parks Department.
