Find rewarding and challenging work with the USDA Forest Service at the Columbia River Gorge National Scenic Area. We are recruiting crew members for our Initial Attack Handcrew based in Cascade Locks and our Wildland Fire Engines based in either Cascade Locks or Hood River.

### **THE POSITIONS**

These positions are temporary seasonal employment as part of our 10-person IA Crew or our Wildland Fire Engine program. Our positions begin in June, and continue into November. Applications for both the Handcrew and Engine crews can be found at <https://www.usajobs.gov/> and will be open on November 30 and close on December 7, 2015.

We also anticipate at least one GS-2 Engine position and/or Hand Crew position that will not need prior fire experience. This announcement number will be:

Prior wildland firefighting experience is preferred, but all applicants with a strong work ethic and a desire to work outdoors in a challenging and dynamic environment are encouraged to apply. Applicants are expected to arrive in excellent physical condition, and must be able to commit to a fire season of uncertain schedules and extremely long shifts of 16 hours or more.

Engine crews are based in Hood River, Cascade Locks or on our state cooperator engines in Husum, Stevenson and The Dalles and are primarily responsible for responding to fires within the Columbia River Gorge and the surrounding area. We have a heavy fire load, with an average of more than 50 fires per year. Engine crewmembers will also participate in off-forest assignments as part of Engine or Hand Crew modules dispatched from the Scenic Area.

Hand Crew positions are located in Cascade Locks and respond to fires locally as well as nationally. The crew averages more than 50 days on fire assignments throughout the Western United States, as well as many additional days on fires with the Columbia River Gorge. Crewmembers are expected to be available for the vast majority of the fire season for long duration assignments away from home of two or more weeks.

### **THE COLUMBIA RIVER GORGE NSA**

The Columbia River Gorge National Scenic Area stretches along the Columbia River between the Deschutes River and the Sandy River in Oregon, and Maryhill and Washougal on the Washington side. The cities of Hood River, The Dalles, Stevenson, White Salmon, and several smaller communities all fall within the Scenic Area. The Portland Metro area borders the Scenic Area 30 miles West of Cascade Locks on Interstate 84.
