Republic Ranger District Temporary Summer Employment 2016

Republic, WA- Individuals interested in seeking temporary employment with USDA Forest Service during the summer of 2016 are invited to attend a help session on Thursday, November 19th, at 6 p.m. at the Republic Ranger Station.

US Forest Service employees will walk through the USA Jobs application process step-by-step, and answer questions about local temporary employment opportunities.

The hiring process for summer positions is happening earlier than it has in past years. Some people may not think about applying until spring time, but by then it will be too late. The application process for next summer will be open November 30 through December 7, we want everyone to be aware of when and how applications are accepted.

Temporary positions are available in Republic and on all districts of the Colville National Forest. Specialties include fire, trails, timber, recreation, wildlife and archaeology. All applicants interested in these positions need to apply online at www.usajobs.gov. You must be a US Citizen and at least 18 years of age as of June 1, 2016.
