The Forest Service will receive sealed and oral bids in public at Colville National Forest Supervisor's Office at 11:00 AM local time on 12/15/2015 for an estimated volume of 85377 ton of Douglas-fir and Other Coniferous Species sawtimber, and 38799 ton of Grand Fir and Hemlock sawtimber marked or otherwise designated for cutting. In addition, there is within the sale area an unestimated volume of All Species grn bio cv that the bidder may agree to remove at a fixed rate. Sale contains specified roads with an estimated public works construction cost of \$120,933.75. Bidders qualifying as small business concerns under the Small Business Act may, when submitting a bid, elect for the Forest Service to build permanent roads. Additional information concerning this option is in the prospectus. The Forest Service reserves the right to reject any and all bids.
