**The public is encouraged to call or stop in and request help starting now until the vacancies close December 7, 2015. Offices are open 8:00 a.m. until 12:00 p.m., and 1:00 until 5:00 p.m.**

The employment offices will have computers and scanners available to use and attach supporting documents such as resumes, school transcripts, military records, letters of recommendation and awards. It is recommended that applicants bring copies of their resumes, cover letters, transcripts and military records. Experienced staff will be on hand to assist with the entire process.

The forest is seeking to fill a number of temporary jobs for the 2016 summer field season and this year's deadline to submit applications is much earlier than in previous years.

***Applications for U.S. Forest Service summer temporary employment will need to be submitted online at [www.usajobs.gov](http://www.usajobs.gov) during an eight-day period that begins on November 30 and extends through December 7, 2015.***

Interested applicants are encouraged to create their USAJOBS.GOV profile now to begin developing their application and compiling the required documentation. Summer temporary employment will be available in a number of fields including wildland firefighting, timber, silviculture, recreation, trails, wildlife, soils, botany, range, fisheries and archeology.
