**WEITAS CREEK BRIDGE HAS REOPENED!**

Road #	Road Description	Status	Date Posted	Condition
103	Lolo Weitas	PARTIALLY OPEN	12/10/15	Road 103 is icy, snow-covered and difficult to navigate. Contact the North Fork Ranger Station for updates.
104	Snowy Summit	PARTIALLY OPEN	12/10/15	Part of Road 104 may be closed due to snow. Contact the North Fork Ranger Station for updates.
246	Scofield Divide -Sourdough	PARTIALLY OPEN	12/10/15	A segment of Scofield-Sourdough Road #246 will close to the public. The closure extends from the junction of Road 246 and Sheep Mountain Road 680 to the junction of Crosstie Road 5380.  These restrictions are necessary for public safety due to road reconstruction activity in the area.  A large landslide makes it impossible for full-sized vehicles to drive Road 246 from end to end. Call the North Fork Ranger Station for details.
247	Beaver Creek (Headquarters to Bungalow)	PARTIALLY OPEN	12/10/15	Part of River Road 247, also called Beaver Creek Road, may be closed due to snow. As always, drive slowly and <i>proceed with care!</i> <b>BE SURE</b> to contact the North Fork Ranger District Office for updates.
252	Skull Creek	OPEN	12/10/15	Skull Creek Road 252 has reopened following last summer's fire closure. Motorists should expect deep snow. Contact the North Fork Ranger Station for updates.
250	Pierce, ID To Superior, MT	PARTIALLY OPEN	12/10/15	Road 250 is open near Pierce, but the road is closed by snow at higher elevations. The road may be icy in spots. <b>BE SURE</b> to contact the North Fork Ranger District Office for updates.
255	Deception Saddle	CLOSED	12/10/15	Road 255 is closed due to snow. <b>BE SURE</b> to contact the North Fork Ranger District office for updates
535	Hemlock	OPEN	12/10/15	The entire length of Hemlock Road 535 has reopened following a temporary fire closure. Contact the North Fork Ranger Station for updates.
547	Hemlock Ridge	OPEN	12/10/15	Road 547 is open. Contact the North Fork Ranger Station for updates.
555	Lean-To-Ridge	OPEN	12/10/15	Road 555 to Weitas Guard Station is open. Contact the North Fork Ranger Station for updates.

669	Shanghai Divide	<b>OPEN</b>	12/10/15	Road 669 is open. <i>BE SURE</i> to contact the North Fork Ranger District office for updates
710	South Skull Creek	<b>OPEN</b>	12/10/15	South Skull Creek Road 710 has reopened following a temporary fire closure. Contact the North Fork Ranger Station for updates.
711	Mush Saddle	<b>OPEN</b>	12/10/15	Road 711 is open to all motorized vehicles. <i>BE SURE</i> to contact the North Fork Ranger District office for updates
715	Fly Hill to boundary of the St. Joe National Forest	<b>CLOSED</b>	12/10/15	Road 715 is closed due to snow . <i>BE SURE</i> to contact the North Fork Ranger District office for updates
720	Cedars Campground To Fly Hill	<b>CLOSED</b>	12/10/15	Road 720 is closed due to snow. <i>BE SURE</i> to contact the North Fork Ranger District office for updates.
5295	Cold Springs Peak Cabin/ Pete Ott Lake access	<b>CLOSED</b>	12/10/15	Road 5295 is closed due to snow . <i>BE SURE</i> to contact the North Fork Ranger District office for updates
