The Forest Service will receive sealed and oral bids in public at Malheur National Forest, Supervisor's Office at 10:00 AM local time on 12/16/2015 for an estimated volume of 1 CCF of Douglas-fir sawtimber, 425 CCF of Ponderosa Pine and other coniferous species sawtimber, and 8 CCF of White Fir sawtimber marked or otherwise designated for cutting. In addition, there is within the sale area an unestimated volume of Miscellaneous non-saw that the bidder may agree to remove at a fixed rate.
