NATIONAL FOREST TIMBER FOR SALE
UMATILLA NATIONAL FOREST

The Hoodoo Salvage Timber Sale is expected to be offered in December, 2015. The volume summary and map are **Draft** at this time. The expected bid date will be January, 2016.

This pre advertisement is to give potential purchasers a chance to have adequate time to view and cruise the proposed salvage. Access will soon be limited by snow depth.

The cutting units are typically within 150 feet of the roads shown on the map, but may be up to 200 feet depending on the tree height.

There is an **estimated** 7800 CCF of sawlog and an additional 1300 CCF of GBCV (Non sawlog). Final volumes have not been established at this point.

Product specifications for the sale are as follows: Ponderosa Pine, the minimum sawlog tree is 7" DBH to a 5" top and no shorter than 16 ft. with trim. All other sawlog species, minimum sawlog tree is, 7" DBH to 5" top and no shorter than 8 ft. with trim. All trees between 5" DBH and 6.9" DBH are shown as Grand Fir (GBCV) in the volume summary. GBCV will be Timber Subject to Agreement in the contract.

Required logging equipment will be Tractor logging in all Units.
