2016 TEMPORARY FIRE POSITIONS

BEAVERHEAD DEERLODGE NATIONAL FOREST



The Beaverhead Deerlodge National Forest will be filling multiple temporary (seasonal) fire positions for the upcoming 2016 fire season. Openings will be available at the GS-3, GS-4, and GS-5 levels and are for wildland fire positions with a maximum six-month tour of duty (not to exceed 1,039 hours). The starting dates of the positions are anticipated to be between April and early June, 2016.
