

Order No. 03-15-103
Eldorado National Forest
Seasonal Closure of Roads and Trails

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50(b), and to protect natural resources, the following acts are prohibited on the Eldorado National Forest. This Order is effective from December 8, 2015 through December 31, 2015.

1. Using a wheeled motorized vehicle on any "Seasonally Designated" road, as shown on the 2015 Eldorado Motor Vehicle Use Map. 36 CFR 261.54(a).
2. Using a wheeled motorized vehicle on any "Seasonally Designated" trail, as shown on the 2015 Eldorado Motor Vehicle Use Map. 36 CFR 261.55(b).


Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Any Federal, State, or local law enforcement officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
2. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
3. Owners or lessees of private land in the area are exempt from Prohibition No. 1 to the extent necessary to gain access to their land.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

A violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571 and 3581.
