### **INTEGRATED RESOURCE TIMBER CONTRACT - STEWARDSHIP**

#### **UMPQUA NATIONAL FOREST**

The Stout's Decks Stew Integrated Resource Timber Contract is located within Sections 32 and 33, T.30S., R.2W.; Sections 24, 25, 27 and 28, T.31S., R.3W.; Sections 4, 5, 8, 9, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 26, 27, 28, 29, 30, 32, 33 and 34, T.31S., R.2W.; Sections 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 8, 10, 11, 12, 15, 16 and 17, T.32S., R.2W., W. M., Surveyed, Douglas County, Oregon. The Forest Service will receive technical and price proposals (no public opening) at the Umpqua National Forest Headquarters, 2900 N.W. Stewart Parkway, Roseburg, Oregon 97471 no later than 1:00 PM local time on or before January 13, 2016 for an estimated volume of 9,230 tons of Douglas-fir and Other Coniferous Species Sawtimber marked or otherwise designated for cutting. In addition, the contract area contains an unestimated volume of biomass material that the bidder may agree to remove at a fixed rate. Also included in the contract are six (6) mandatory restoration service projects to be completed by the Contractor. The contract will be awarded based on a Best Value determination. One award will be made to the Bidder, (a) whose proposal is technically acceptable, and (b) whose technical/price relationship is the most advantageous to the Government. The Forest Service reserves the right to reject any and all technical and price proposals. Interested parties may obtain a prospectus from the office listed below.
