

Order No. 03-15-07
Eldorado National Forest
Winter Vehicle Use Restrictions

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50(b), and to protect natural resources and provide for public safety, the following acts are prohibited within the Eldorado National Forest. This Order is effective from December 11, 2015 through December 11, 2017. For purposes of this Order, a wheelchair is not considered to be a vehicle.

Using a motor vehicle on the Mormon Emigrant Trail (Forest Road No. 10N50) when snow covers the road, as shown on Exhibit A.
36 CFR 261.54(a).

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons using a snowmobile, all-terrain vehicle or recreational off-highway vehicle, as defined in California Vehicle Code Sections 557, 111, and 500, are exempt from Prohibition No. 1.
2. Persons using a tracked vehicle or highway-legal 4-wheel drive passenger vehicle, as defined in California Vehicle Code Section 465, are exempt from Prohibition No. 1.
3. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
4. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.


This prohibition is in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR 261, Subpart A.

A violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571 and 3581.

Road closed to all motor vehicles, except snowmobiles, all-terrain vehicles, recreational off-highway vehicles, tracked vehicles and highway-legal wheel drive passenger vehicles.

MWUM Road Allowed Uses

- Roads Open to All Vehicles, Yearlong
- Roads Open to All Vehicles, Seasonal
- Roads Open to Highway Legal Vehicles Only, Yearlong
- Roads Open to Highway Legal Vehicles Only, Seasonal
- MWUM Trail Allowed Uses
- Trails Open to All Vehicles, Seasonal
- Trails Open to Motorcycles Only, Seasonal
- Trails Open to Wheeled Vehicles Only < 50" or Less in Width, Seasonal
