

**Forest Order No. 08-16-01**  
**Mendocino National Forest**  
**Road Closure**

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50(b), and to protect natural resources, the following act is prohibited within the Covelo and Grindstone Ranger Districts of the Mendocino National Forest. This Order is effective from January 2, 2016, through May 26, 2016.

Being on the National Forest System roads listed below and shown on the attached map:

1. Forest Road No. 24N21 from Hams Pass, then north to its terminus.
2. Forest Road No. M1 (Indian Dick Rd.) from Boardman Ridge, then north to its terminus.
3. Forest Road No. M1 (Etsel Ridge Rd.) from Bentley Ridge, then south to its intersection with Forest Road No. M61.
4. Forest Road No. 22N11, approximately 1 mile south of Forest Highway 7, then southeast to its intersection with Forest Highway 7.

36 CFR 261.54(e).

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Any Federal, State or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of official duty.
2. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
3. Owners or lessees of private land in the area, to the extent necessary to access their land.

This prohibition is in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

A violation of this prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 for an individual or \$10,000.00 for an organization or imprisonment for not more than six months or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571 and 3581.



