ORDER NO. 06-10-20-16-04
ROGUE RIVER-SISKIYOU NATIONAL FOREST
Temporary area closure to provide for public health and safety

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(a) and (b), and to provide for public safety, the following act is prohibited within the Siskiyou Mountains Ranger District of the Rogue River-Siskiyou National Forest. This Order is effective from March 14, 2016, until April 30, 2016, or until sooner rescinded.

1) Going into or being upon National Forest System within T.39S., R.1E., portions of Sections 21, 27, 28, 34, and 35, and T.40S., R.1E., portions of Sections 1, 2, 3, 10, 11, 12, 14, and 15 Willamette Meridian, as shown on the attached map. This includes the area north of 4 Corners and south and west of the National Forest boundary. Portions of Forest Service Roads 2060, 2080, and 2080600 and all of Trails 1015 (Lamb Saddle), 1004 (Caterpillar), 1003 (Catwalk), 1010 (Toothpick), 1012 (Eastview) and 1017 (Bull Gap) are included in this order. **36 C.F.R. 261.53(e)**

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from the Order:

- 1) Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
- 2) Any Federal, State or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 C.F.R. Part 261, Subpart A.

A violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, or both. 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 18 U.S.C. §§ 3559, 3571, and 3581.
