Firewood and post and pole sales set to begin Monday, January 11, 2016

JOHN DAY, PRAIRIE CITY, AND HINES, ORE. – The forest is pleased to confirm systems are in place for the New Year and personal use firewood and post and pole permits for 2016 will go on sale beginning promptly on January 11.

The price for personal use firewood permits remains at \$5.00 per cord, with a four cord minimum purchase. The personal use firewood program allows for a maximum of 16 cords per household, per year.

Post and pole permits are available for the harvesting of post and poles in designated locations. The minimum purchase price of a post and pole permit is \$20.00.

- **Prairie City Ranger District** office between the hours of 8:00 to 11:30 a.m. and 12:30 to 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, or by calling 541-820-3800.
- **Emigrant Creek Ranger District is currently closed until further notice.** Harney County residents may contact the Supervisors office at 541-575-3000 to obtain a permit for the south half of the forest.
