# Step by Step Guide: Putting USFS geo-referenced 7.5 minute quad maps on your phone and mobile device



Android and Iphone

## How to load maps onto your phone:

1. Go to Google Play Store or Apple App Store.
2. Search "PDF Maps", by Avenza Systems, Inc.
3. Download the FREE app.
4. Scan the appropriate Custer Gallatin NF QR code on the inside fold (if you do not have a QR code scanner, download one of many QR code apps).
5. The QR code will take you directly to the correct website to download geo-referenced quad maps.
6. Find the map you want and download it (either to your mobile device or to Dropbox, if you have this app).
7. Open PDF Maps and click on the "+" icon to import the map into the app. Select "from device storage" or "from Dropbox", depending on where you downloaded it.
8. Wait for the map to import. When this is completed, you will have the geo-referenced quad map on your phone or mobile device.

Because the map is downloaded to your phone, you **do not** need cell phone reception


Scan below for nationwide quad maps of all US Forests:








Want to remember a location? Drop a pin, attach a photo to that location, or use it to save GPS coordinates.



The maps Geo-locate, which means it will show you where you are on the map!

Click the upper left icon to show your location. No cell phone reception is needed. Just make sure your phone GPS is turned on!
