Entry Guidelines

Artwork must include birds, avian habitat and/or migratory bird patterns from the list provided on the back page.
Artwork must be recent, original and not previously exhibited in Ketchikan, Alaska.
Open to all Alaskan artists working in all media with a maximum of two entries per artist.
Label each piece with "item 1" and "item 2" to correspond with each entry form.
All two-dimensional entries must be framed and ready to hang (hardware, wire etc.)
All three-dimensional entries must be ready for display. Note on entry form if you are including stands or props with your piece.
You may sell your artwork at the exhibit. Proceeds benefit the artist (65%) with 25% going to SEADC educational programs including this juried art show and 10% to KVB.
