## **Klamath National Forest hiring seasonal workforce for 2016 season**

**Yreka, Calif.** – Anyone interested in becoming a wildland firefighter or applying for a summer job with the Forest Service should know 2016 seasonal positions with all California forests will be filled through a centralized-hiring process.

Duty locations on the Klamath National Forest include Callahan and Scott Bar, Fort Jones, Sawyers Bar, Cecilville, Happy Camp and Seiad Valley, Klamath River, and Macdoel. Available positions include fire, (helitack, hotshot and engine crew), botany, archeology, business administration, wildlife, recreation (trail crew), timber, and engineering. Not all positions are available at all locations.

The five-day vacancy announcements for all temporary Fire Management positions in California will open on USA Jobs (<https://www.usajobs.gov/>) today, Monday, Jan. 11 and close on Friday, Jan. 15, 2016.

Non-fire summer workforce positions will open on USA Jobs Monday, Jan. 25 and close on Friday, Jan. 29, 2016.

Applicants will need to create a profile and resume on the USA Jobs website and are encouraged to read the vacancy announcements thoroughly for specific information about job requirements and how to apply.
