

Preliminary Advertisement
Sale of National Forest Timber

The Forest Service intends to advertise timber designated for cutting in the following proposed contract area on the Plumas National Forest after April 1, 2016. The Gilson Stewardship Contract contains an estimated 77.2 acres in six payment cutting units within Sec 12 and 13 of T25N, R9E; and Sec 18, 19 and 20 of T25N, R10E; MDBM. This area can be reached from the community of Quincy via PC 406 (Quincy Junction), PC 403 (Mount Hough), north on FS Road 25N14, and north on FS Road 25N19, to the sale area (please refer to map). This sale contains an estimated volume of 1,577 hundred cubic feet (CCF) of timber designated for cutting with BLUE tracer paint; and a Stewardship Work Item to cut, skid and deck an estimated biomass unmarked volume of 382.2 CCF to landings from within the payment units.

This advance notice is to afford interest parties time to examine the contract area prior to winter. Since winter conditions are now present, access can be by 4-wheel drive vehicle and/or by snowmobile, as road conditions permit.
