Tahoe National Forest Names Eli Ilano Acting Forest Supervisor

NEVADA CITY, Calif. – Eli Ilano has been named by the Forest Service to serve as Acting Forest Supervisor of the Tahoe National Forest. He brings years of natural resource and public land management experience, including working for the past five years as the Deputy Forest Supervisor of the Tahoe National Forest. His past experience also involves working for the Bureau of Land Management, United States Senate, and in the non-profit sector, in communities around the country, focusing on natural resource issues.

When asked how he feels about being the Acting Forest Supervisor, Eli responded, “I’m excited to continue working with the communities and employees in and around the Tahoe National Forest; this is a special place to be a part of.”

Eli earned a Bachelor’s Degree in Economics from the University of California at Santa Cruz in 1995, a Master’s Degree in Environmental Policy and Landscape Architecture in 2001, and a Master’s Degree in City and Regional Planning in 2001, both from the University of California at Berkeley.

Eli Ilano will be the Acting Forest Supervisor for the Tahoe National Forest until the agency names a permanent replacement for Tom Quinn, who retired on January 3, 2016, after 35 years with the Forest Service.
