Step by Step Guide:

Putting USFS geo-referenced 7.5 minute quad maps on your phone and mobile device



Because the map is downloaded
to your phone, you **do not**
need cell phone reception
to view the map!

Android and Iphone

How to load maps onto your phone:


1. Go to Google Play Store or Apple App Store.
2. Search "PDF Maps", by Avenza Systems, Inc.
3. Download the FREE app.
4. Scan the appropriate Custer Gallatin NF QR code on the inside fold (if you do not have a QR code scanner, download one of many QR code apps).
5. The QR code will take you directly to the correct website to download geo-referenced quad maps.
6. Now follow the appropriate directions for Android or iPhone.

Android Devices


1. Find the map you want and download it (it will save to your device storage or to Dropbox).
2. Open PDF Maps and click on the "+" icon to import the map into the app. Select "from device storage" or "from Dropbox", depending on where you downloaded it.
3. Wait for the map to import and return to the "maps" page for download progress and to view map

Apple Devices (iPhone and iPad)

1. Find the map you want and click it. This will open the map.
2. Click the options icon in the upper right (3 vertical dots), then the "save/print" icon (box with upward arrow), then hit "copy". This will copy the link for the map.
3. Open PDF maps, hit the "+" icon in upper right corner, then paste the link in the "From The Web" section. This will import your map.


The maps Geolocate, which means it will show you where you are on the map!

Click the upper left icon to show your location. No cell phone reception is needed. Just make sure your phone GPS is turned on!

For iPhones, the options are the same, but the icons are at the bottom of the screen.



Want to remember a location? Drop a pin, attach a photo to that location, or use it to save GPS coordinates.



There are many options for charting your course, measuring distances, etc.
