Course Information: This course focuses on identification, biology, impacts, and management of the major forest insect pests and diseases in Region 2. Students will learn about insects and diseases by host and forest type with an emphasis on defoliators, bark beetles, root diseases, stem decays, and stem rusts. An 8 hour field session is included.

Objectives: Students will leave this course able to identify and detect impacts from common forest insects and diseases in the Rocky Mountain Region. Additionally, students will acquire a general understanding of organism behavior and the principals of insect and disease management.

In AgLearn:

- When [3400 R2 Forest Insect and Disease Identification and Management](#) appears:
- Place your cursor over the title and **Click** the title to open it up

 - Select **Register**
