

TEMPORARY CLOSURE ORDER

CONDITIONS OF USE

MARK TWAIN NATIONAL FOREST

This Temporary Closure Order is valid under Authority of the Act of Congress of June 4, 1897, as amended, (16 U.S.C. 551) and pursuant to the Secretary of Agriculture's Regulations set forth at 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart B (36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b)). These restrictions are in addition to those enumerated in Code of Federal Regulations Title 36, Part 261, Subpart A, and become effective when signed and will remain in effect until rescinded.

THE AREA KNOWN AS JOHNSON MOUNTAIN ON THE POTOSI/FREDERICKTOWN RANGER DISTRICT OF THE MARK TWAIN NATIONAL FOREST IS CLOSED TO THE PUBLIC ON FEBRUARY 3rd, 2016 FROM 8:00AM TO 5:00PM AS DESCRIBED BELOW AND IS NECESSARY FOR PUBLIC HEALTH AND SAFETY (36 CFR 261.53 d & e and 26 CFR 261.54 a & e).

All NFS Lands within the legal description are temporarily closed to the public.

All Forest Service Roads accessing the above NFS Lands are temporarily closed to the public: FR 2245, FR2780.

Violations of these Prohibitions are punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual and \$10,000 for an organization or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, or both. [16 USC 551, 18 USC 3559 and 3571].
