### **Eagle Lake Ranger District:**

There will be no more grooming on the Eagle Lake District this season.

### **Hat Creek Ranger District:**

Due to the warm weather, Ashpan is 50% open with 25 miles groomed, and the Latour system is 30% open with 15 miles groomed. This week we will start removing all signage – trail, caution, and helicopter medi-vac signs – before we lose snow on the lower 16 Road. Please be aware of hazards on the entire system. the lower system is holding 1 foot, and the upper areas (Latour and Battle Creek) are holding 6-8 feet. Future grooming will take place on a temperature-dependent basis. As always ride "right" and watch for the groomer and other riders.

### **Almanor Ranger District:**

\*Grooming was scheduled to take place on Saturday, February 20 on all trail systems except Tamarack, but we have not yet received official confirmation.
