Opportunity Description: Volunteer Campground Hosts are invaluable members to the developed recreation program on the Seeley Lake Ranger District. We have one of the largest and busiest campground programs in Western Montana and our hosts play a crucial role in our ability to interact with Forest visitors and perform light maintenance duties necessary to keep our campgrounds functioning in an efficient manner. The primary role of campground hosts on the district is to be available as a resource to visitors and to provide information on local recreation opportunities in an effort to provide the absolute best recreation experience possible.

Other Duties Include:

- Regularly cleaning restroom facilities
- Picking up litter from campsites, beaches, and throughout campgrounds
- Cleaning picnic tables
- Communicating with Forest Service staff regarding campground needs
- Visiting with campers to provide information and education on opportunities and regulations
- Maintaining a positive and professional attitude at all times

Additional Information: Campground hosts are expected to work 5 days a week with two days off per week. Hosts are expected to work weekends and holidays. Hours will vary depending on use levels in the campgrounds. These positions receive no remuneration. However, a free RV site is provided with full hook-ups including water, sewer, electricity, and LAN line phone service.
