

**ORDER
USDA - FOREST SERVICE
KAIBAB NATIONAL FOREST
Dispersed Camping Restrictions**

Pursuant to Title 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited in areas as described in this Order on National Forest System lands administered by the Kaibab National Forest, in Coconino and Yavapai Counties in Arizona, and as depicted on the attached maps, hereby incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A.

PROHIBITIONS:

1. Camping for a period longer than 14-days within any 30-day period; **36 CFR 261.58(a)**.
2. Camping within a one mile radius of a developed recreation site; **36 CFR 261.58(e)**.

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e) the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty; and
2. Person(s) with a Forest Service permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.

AREAS DESCRIBED

This Order affects all lands administered by the Kaibab National Forest, as more specifically described and depicted by Exhibit A.

PURPOSE:

This order is needed to prevent impacts to natural resources and to provide opportunities for other forest users to access camping areas.

IMPLEMENTATION:

1. This Order will be in effect when signed and shall remain in effect until May 31, 2020 or until rescinded, whichever event occurs first.
2. This Order rescinds, replaces and supersedes any previous Orders prohibiting the same acts covered by this Order in that area addressed by Exhibit A.
