

Notice of Administrative Change - Nez Perce Forest Plan

On February 1, 2016, Forest Supervisor Cheryl Probert decided to make an administrative change (36 CFR 219.13(c)) to the Nez Perce Forest Plan to be in conformance with the regulatory requirements of the 2005 Travel Management Rule (36 CFR 212). Nez Perce Forest Plan text in the following areas will be modified: Recreation standard #9; Roads and Trails standard #10; Management Area 16 – Wildlife-Access Management standard #1; Glossary terms; and Appendix Q. The text changes relate to the designation of road, trails or areas open or closed to motor vehicle use. This new administrative direction also changes how the public is informed of where they may travel using motorized vehicles on the Nez Perce National Forest.

The responsible official for this decision is Forest Supervisor, Cheryl Probert. An on-line publication of this notice is the only required notice (36 CFR 219.13(c) and 36 CFR 219.16 (c)). The change will be effective immediately.
