



Open House Meetings to Be Held Kootenai National Forest

Rock Creek Project Draft SEIS

Two open house meetings will be held to allow the public the opportunity to ask resource specialists questions on the Draft Supplemental Environmental Impact Statement (SEIS) for the Rock Creek Project. The first meeting will be held in Noxon on Tuesday March 15, 2016 at the Noxon High School Multipurpose Center, 300 Noxon Ave, Noxon, MT, from 6:00 pm to 8:00 pm. The second meeting will be held in Libby on Wednesday March 16, 2016 at the City Hall Ponderosa Room, 952 E. Spruce St., Libby, MT from 6:00 pm to 8:00 pm.

The Rock Creek Project is a proposed underground copper and silver mine located in northwestern Montana near Noxon in Sanders County in the Cabinet Mountains of northwestern Montana. As required by the National Environmental Policy Act, the Kootenai National Forest, the lead agency designated for this project, has prepared a Draft SEIS in response to a March 29, 2010, U.S. District Court decision in Rock Creek Alliance et al. v. USFS, Revett Silver Company, and USFWS (CV 05-107-M-DWM and CV 08-028-M-DWM consolidated). A copy of this Draft SEIS can be downloaded from the Forest Service's web page:
