**ROAD CLOSURE**

*National Forest System Roads 101, 101F, 101G, 101H, 130, 130A1, 130A2, 130A3,  
130A4, 130A5, 130A6, 130A7 130D, 130D1, 136 and 139  
For Public Safety and Wildlife Protection*

**PROHIBITIONS**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(b), the following act is prohibited on the National Forest System Roads described in this order, within the administrative boundaries of the Mountain Home Ranger District, Boise National Forest. This order will be in effect upon signing and will remain in effect until April 30, 2016 at 11:59 PM.

1. Using a motorized vehicle on a road (as described below) **36 CFR 261.54(a)**

**EXEMPTIONS**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a special use authorization or other Forest Service authorization specifically exempting them from the effect of this order.
2. Any Federal, State, or local law enforcement officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Federal or State administrative personnel in the performance of an official duty.
4. Planting contractors and their employees and agents while planting in the Elk Reforestation area.

**AREA AND ROAD DESCRIPTION**

All affected National Forest System (NFS) Roads are within Township 1 North, Range 8 East; Township 2 North, Range 8 East; Township 1 North, Range 9 East; and Township 2 North, Range 9 East, Boise Meridian, within the Mountain Home Ranger District, Boise National Forest, Elmore County, Idaho.

The entire length of the following National Forest System Roads are closed: **101, 101F, 101G, 101H, 130, 130A1, 130A2, 130A3, 130A4, 130A5, 130A6, 130A7 130D, 130D1, 136, and 139.**

**PURPOSE**

To provide for public safety, prevent road damage, and to protect wintering wildlife on plowed roads impacted by the Elk Reforestation effort.

**IMPLEMENTATION**

1. This order will be in effect when signed and will remain in effect until April 30, 2016 at 11:59 PM.
2. A map identifying the above-described area is attached to and made part of this order.
3. Any violation of this order is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, and/or imprisonment for not more than six months [Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3571(b)(6), Title 18 USC 3581 (b)(7)].
4. This order supersedes any previous orders/notices for the above-described roads or portions thereof.
