

TRAVEL MANAGEMENT

Change is coming to the White River National Forest Spring 2012.

In Spring 2012, on the ground implementation of the Travel Management Plan for the White River National Forest will begin. The plan addresses motorized and non-motorized travel and recreation on the Forest during both the summer and winter seasons. As implementation begins, Forest users may start to see changes on the ground. We encourage you to be informed during the implementation process as visitors will be responsible for knowing where motorized and mechanized vehicles are allowed on the Forest.

In some locations, you will experience the White River National Forest this year may be different from next year. We encourage you to learn more about travel management decisions as you make plans for the 2012 hunting seasons.

PLANEACIÓN DE VIAJES

Se avecinan cambios para la primavera del 2012 en el Bosque Nacional White River.

El Bosque Nacional White River tiene un nuevo mapa para viajar. Éste incluye un mapa de vehículos motorizados, mecánicos y recreativos durante las temporadas de verano e invierno.

En la primavera del 2012 se implementará un mapa para el uso de vehículos motorizados (MVUM por sus siglas en inglés) dentro del bosque. En la medida en que se lleve a cabo esta implementación, los usuarios podrán ver algunos cambios sobre el terreno. Manténganse informados durante este proceso puesto que los visitantes serán responsables de saber dónde y cuándo está permitido el uso de vehículos motorizados y mecánicos en el bosque.
