

ORDER NO. 15-05-771
KLAMATH NATIONAL FOREST
EMERGENCY CLOSURE

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50(b), and to provide for public safety, the following acts are prohibited within the Happy Camp/Oak Knoll Ranger and Salmon/Scott Ranger Districts of the Klamath National Forest. This Order is effective from March 30, 2016 until March 29, 2017.

Being on the Forest Roads listed below and shown on Exhibit A.

1. Forest Road 46N64 (Tom Walker Road)
2. Forest Road 46N65 (Lake Mountain Road)
3. Forest Road 45N71 (Tom Martin Road), beginning at the intersection with Forest Road 46N65 and continuing due east to its terminus
4. Forest Road 45N05Y (Eagle springs Road)
5. Forest Road 45N65 (East Tompkins Road)

36 CFR 261.54(e).

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a permit from the Forest Service specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Owners or lessees of private land to the extent necessary to gain access to their land.

This prohibition are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

A violation of this prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559, 3571, and 3581.


