Request For Quote second set of Questions and Answers:

Per Request For Quote, Page 3 of 23, item 6, Provide and route power extension cords and data cables through panels, if the panels covers the ports. Does the contractor need to provide the power extension cords and data cables? The contractor will need to provide the power strips. Eight each of the six foot with six outlet power strips. In addition the telephone cables will also need to be routed through or behind the panels with the data and power cables. The government will provide the telephone and data (Ethernet) cables.


Will an electrician be available to install the electrical? No, electrician will be available.

Are there plans that show where the drawers and shelving are going? Yes, see the updated map. The updated map identifies the location of the drawers and shelving.

Question from Amendment 001 Is there other items in storage in front of the furniture and parts?
Will items need to be moved to get to the excess furniture? Some of the items are behind other pallets. A Forest Service employee will be present during pickup and are available to operate a forklift to move the pallets for accessibility. It will be the responsibility of the contractor to identify the items listed on the map. Below are six photos that show the items stored at the warehouse.
