



Ok to remove post/poles with permit from recently horizontally stacked green pine piles along FR248, FR248A & FR247 (shown green on map) unless prescribed burning operations are active.


- North Kaibab Ranger District Boundary

Approved Cutting Areas:

- The white area on Map (within District Boundary) is approved for fuelwood gathering. Within the ponderosa pine, aspen, spruce &/or fir habitat, driving beyond 30 feet off roads to look for post/poles is prohibited. However, if legal dead post/poles (as defined by permit) is located beyond 30' via hiking, horseback or visually spotting from the road then permittees are authorized to make one trip in and out.
- The green areas on map contain ponderosa pine piles located on Forest Service Roads 248, 248A and 247. Post/pole gathering is permitted from these HORIZONTALLY STACKED PILES if there is no fire activity in the area.
- Yellow areas on map contain pinyon and juniper. Gathering of dead post/poles is permitted but motorized vehicles are NOT authorized beyond 30 feet off roads.

No Cutting/No Post/Pole Gathering Areas:

- The red areas are prohibited from ALL cutting and gathering of post/poles. These areas include timber sale & thinning contract areas; research areas, wilderness areas, pediocactus habitat and meadows. Off-road motorized travel is prohibited in meadows such as Little Round Valley, Little Pleasant Valley & DeMotte Park.
