Strong leader, high-energy and innovative, likes fast-paced and challenging work environments and enjoys working with diverse communities! ***We are seeking a detailer to fill a Supervisory Forestry Technician (Airbase Manager), GS-0462-10 on the Uinta-Wasatch-Cache National Forest (N.F.), duty station in Ogden, Utah.***

Wasatch Helitack

- The base is located in Mountain Green, UT at the Morgan airport.
- The initial attack area has many wildland-urban interface areas, near high-value improvements, with many interagency jurisdictions. It encompasses the Uinta-Wasatch-Cache N.F., Ashley N.F., and parts of Manti-Lasal N.F and Fishlake N.F.
- The program has four helicopters: Bell 212 HP medium, 2- Bell 407 light, and a KMAX heavy. They are staffed with a flexible "jump list" type approach.
- The medium and heavy are available nationwide, during their entire contract.
- The two lights are made available nationally as local conditions warrant.
- The crew consists of two Superintendent GS-9 PFTs, four Assistant GS-8 18/8s, four Lead GS-7 13/13s, four Senior GS-5 13/13 or Apprentices, and fifteen HECM temps.
- The crew does not currently rappel or do short hauls although short haul is being considered for the future.

Position Description:

- Leadership, provides supervision and human resource management to subordinates.
- Responsible for coordination of the helitack crew for projects, firefighting and fuels activities.
- Provides helicopter oversight and technical expertise for helicopter projects.
- Coordinates staffing of the aircraft.
- Ensures preparedness of equipment and personnel.
- Assists in updating annual operating plans.
- Responsible for the on-the-job safety and health of all employees supervised.
- May be designated Contracting Officer Representative (COR) or alternate COR for the helicopter contracts assigned to the base.
- Participates in fire response as qualified, such as Helicopter Manager, team assignments, or with other line/aviation quals or training opportunities.
