**TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE ORDER**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(a) & (b), the following act is prohibited on lands administered by the Forest Service within the Idaho Panhandle National Forests:

**Using any type of motorized vehicle upon the following described National Forest roads (36 CFR 261.54(a)): Lightning Creek Road #419, between milepost 7.822, the junction of road #1184, in T57N, R3E, NW ¼ Section 32, B.M and the junction of road #473 in T.58N, R3E, SW Section 23. The temporary road closure order is to provide for public health and safety (36CFR 261.53(e)).**

This restriction is in addition to those stated in Title 36 Code of Federal Regulations, Part 261, Subpart A and becomes effective starting April 22, 2016 at 7:00a.m. This closure is necessary for public safety due to multiple flood damage segments along the road.


The following individuals are exempt from this prohibition pursuant to 36CFR 261.50(e):

1. Any federal, State, or local Officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force.
2. Persons with a permit from the District Ranger, in their possession.

**TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE ORDER**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(a) & (b), the following act is prohibited on lands administered by the Forest Service within the Idaho Panhandle National Forests:

**Using any type of motorized vehicle upon the following described National Forest roads (36 CFR 261.54(a)): Boulder Creek Road #314 between milepost 15.0 at the Boulder Creek Bridge, in T61N, R3E, NE ¼ Section 32, B.M. and the junction of road #314 and Road # 4402 milepost 15.6 , in T61N, R3E, SW ¼ Section 32. The temporary road closure order is to provide for public health and safety (36CFR 261.53(e)).**

This restriction is in addition to those stated in Title 36 Code of Federal Regulations, Part 261, Subpart A and becomes effective starting April 22, 2016 at 7:00 a.m. This closure is necessary for public safety due to multiple flood damage segments along the road.

The following individuals are exempt from this prohibition pursuant to 36CFR 261.50(e):

1. Any federal, State, or local Officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force.
2. Persons with a permit from the District Ranger, in their possession.
