

ORDER NO. 91-05-315

KLAMATH NATIONAL FOREST

RESTRICTED USE-WATERCRAFT

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (b), the use of electric or gasoline powered watercraft is prohibited on the surface waters of Juanita Lake (T46N,R2W,Sec.20). This prohibition is necessary to reduce the potential for water pollution, to provide for the safety of other users and to enhance visitor experience.


Use by any type of electric or gasoline powered watercraft is prohibited by the order: 36 CFR 261.58(n).

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e), each of the following persons is exempt from this order:

1. Any Federal, State or local officer, or member of an organized search or rescue force in the performance of an official duty.
2. Persons with a valid permit signed by the District Ranger to use prohibited watercraft.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR, Part 261, Subpart A.
