On April 25, 2016 USDA Forest Service Lake Tahoe Basin Management Unit (LTBMU) Forest Supervisor, Jeff Marsolais signed a Decision Notice/Finding of No Significant Impact (DN/FONSI) for the Restoration of Fire Adapted Ecosystems Project Environmental Assessment (EA). The DN/FONSI selects Alternative 2 (Proposed Action), which will restore ecological and hydrological characteristics of six meadows (Baldwin, Benwood, Freel, Hellhole, Meiss, and Star Meadows) so that these systems are prepared for natural disturbances in the future. The EA and DN /FONSI are available for review at the Lake Tahoe Basin Management Unit, 35 College Drive, South Lake Tahoe, CA 96150 and can be found on the following website: <http://www.fs.usda.gov/goto/lbmu/FireAdaptedEcosystems>. This decision was subject to a pre-decisional administrative review (objection process) pursuant to 36 CFR Part 218, Subparts A and B. The EA was available to the public for a 45-day objection period between January 27 and March 14, 2016. No objections were received. Pre-project monitoring will begin this year with implementation possibly beginning shortly after.
