Stirrup Oil Field

Pursuant to Title 16, United States Code (U.S.C.) § Section 551, and Title 36 Code of Federal Regulations (C.F.R.) § 261.50 (b), the following acts are prohibited on/within the Stirrup Oil Field on the Cimarron National Grassland, Morton County, Kansas described as west of Hwy 51 and bordering the Cimarron National Grassland for 2 miles east in proximity to the Cimarron River Corridor. The restricted area is depicted on the attached map, hereby incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A.

PROHIBITION:

1. Access within or using any motorized vehicle on the Restricted Roads. 36 C.F.R. § 261.54 (a).

Exemptions:

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from the Order:

1. Persons with a written Forest Service authorization specifically exempting them from the effect of this order.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force, in the performance of an official duty.

This Forest Order shall become effective on May 2, 2016, and shall remain in effect through December 31, 2016 or until rescinded, whichever event occurs first.

Violation of these prohibitions is punishable as a Class B Misdemeanor by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for a legal entity other than an individual, or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, or both (16 U.S.C. § 551 and 18 U.S.C. §§ 3559 and 3571).
