



## Free Use Permits

Products	Amounts (limits)	Time
<b>Cedar Bark</b>	25 - strips per year	From 2 weeks to 1 month depending on the permitting district.
<b>Wild Berries</b> <i>Blackberries, Blue Elderberries, Salal Berries, Huckleberries, Oregon Grape, Salmon berries, Wild Strawberries</i>	5 gallons per year	From 2 weeks to 1 month depending on the permitting district.
<b>Forest Green Cuttings</b> <i>Fiddlehead Ferns, Salal, sword ferns, Evergreen Huckleberry, Oregon Grape</i>	5 lbs. per year	From 2 weeks to 1 month depending on the permitting district.
<b>Mushrooms</b>	5 gallons per year per household	From 2 weeks to 1 month depending on the permitting district.
<b>Transplant Shrubs, Ferns, Small Plants</b>	5 - transplants total per year per household	From 2 weeks to 1 month depending on the permitting district.
<b>Conifer Transplants</b> <i>Douglas Fir, Western Red Cedar, Western Hemlock only</i>	5 total per year per household	From 2 weeks to 1 month depending on the permitting district.
<b>Hardwood Transplants</b> Alder, Cottonwood, Maple	5 total per year per household	From 2 weeks to 1 month depending on the permitting district.

*Gathering, harvesting, or collecting is Prohibited inside the Legislated Wilderness Areas, Research Natural Areas, Experimental Forests, and other administratively closed areas. Harvesting rare, threatened or endangered plants is illegal. Contact the nearest Ranger District office for additional information.*

<b>Transplant Trees</b> <i>(Douglas fir, Western Red Cedar, Western Hemlock, Alder, Maple) - &lt;2' tall cutbank only</i>	No limit	\$5 each	1 month
<b>Transplant Shrubs, Ferns, Small plants</b> <i>(personal use)</i>	20 per household	\$2 each	1 month
