# **2016 Industrial Camping Permit Commercial Mushroom Harvesting Fact Sheet**

***Commercial Harvesting = picking with intentions of selling for a profit.***

***Industrial Camping = camping for the purpose of commercial harvesting.***

- Industrial camping permits for the Malheur National Forest will be issued for those picking commercially and must be hung/posted in plain view for Law Enforcement/Forest Officials monitoring the sites.
- There is no charge for an Industrial camping permit.
- Industrial camping permit is required if you plan to set up camp overnight on National Forest lands while commercially harvesting mushrooms.
- Commercial harvesters are prohibited from camping in developed campgrounds.
- Industrial camping permits can only be obtained on the Forest/District in which you plan to pick. If changing camp sites, a new camping permit must be obtained for the camp site in which you plan to stay. ***When you vacate your campsite, please notify the Forest at 541-575-3000 to end your reservation.***
- Industrial camping permits follow the regulatory forest stay limits, with a maximum of 14-Day stay limit.
- Industrial camping sites for the Malheur National Forest include:
  - Deardorff Rock Pit
  - Oregon Mine Rock Pit
  - Bear Valley Work Center
  - Starr Snowpark
  - Parish Cabin Rock Pit
  - Shoestring Glade Rock Pit
- While some restricted areas are listed on the Industrial Camp Site Maps, other restricted areas exist across the forest. It is up to the permit holder to be aware of these areas and other restrictions listed in the guide.
- Numerous active timber sales are underway across the forest, creating extra log haul traffic on forest roads; please use caution when traveling.
- Area Closure boundary's will be adjusted throughout the season as hazards are reduced. Please be sure to follow up at a district office near you for the latest updates. ***Area closure refers to an area that allows NO ACCESS of any type at the time.***
