Chapter 4: Monitoring, Evaluation and
Research

Forest Service planning regulations (36 CFR 219) published in 2012 changed Forest Plan monitoring requirements. The planning rule requires that every Forest's monitoring plan be updated by May 9, 2016, to address eight resource items with at least one monitoring question and associated indicator(s). The Shawnee National Forest has updated the monitoring plan and made the required administrative change to the Forest Plan, replacing the Forest's monitoring plan in its entirety. These changes may be viewed on the Forest website as proposed in early April. No comments were received.
