ROAD CLOSURE

PROHIBITIONS:

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50(b), the following acts are prohibited on the roads described in this order, on the Beaver Ranger District, Fishlake National Forest until further notice:

1. Using any motor vehicle upon the roads described below, which are closed for the protection of public health and safety. [Title 36 CFR 261.53(e)]

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempted from the prohibition contained in this Order:

1. Owners of homes and private property in the closed area. [Title 36 CFR 261.50(e)(2-3)]
2. Persons with a Forest Service permit specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order. [Title 36 CFR 261.50(d)(1)]
3. Any Federal, State, or local officer; or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty. [Title 36 CFR 261.50(e)(4)]
4. Federal or State administrative personnel in the performance of an official duty.

ROADS DESCRIPTION:

The closed roads are depicted on the map attached as Exhibit A, and specifically described as follows

- Road Number 577 in Revenue Gulch from the National Forest Boundary to the junction with Bullion Canyon Road,(T27S.,R4.5W., Sections 27 and 34) and
- Road Number 126 from the Forest Boundary to Miner's Park T27S., R4.5 W., Sections 33 and 34).

PURPOSE:

This order is intended for public safety during mining waste reclamation work on adjacent lands.

IMPLEMENTATION:

1. This order will be in effect beginning May 16, 2016 and shall remain in effect until May 20, 2016 or until rescinded, whichever is earlier.
2. A map identifying the roads that may be restricted is attached and made part of this order.

3. Violation of the above prohibition is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 for an individual, or \$10,000.00 for an organization, and/or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months. [Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3571(b)(6), Title 18 USC 3581(b)(7)].

5. This order supersedes any previous order(s) prohibiting the same, or similar acts prohibited by this order in the areas covered by this order.


