**Occupancy and Use on National Forest System Lands**

**Road and Trail Closure**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(b), the following travel routes are closed as described and as indicated in the area displayed on the attached map within the Priest Lake Ranger District of the Idaho Panhandle National Forests.

**Being on or using road 305 west of the T34N R45, WM Section 27 and 34 section boundary.**

**Being on or using road 659 west of the 659/1108 road junction in T34N R45E Section 2, WM.**

**Being on or using road 1089 west of the 659/1089 road junction in T34N R45E Section 2, WM.**

**Being on or using road 1075 and it's spurs west of the 1075/312 road junction in T35N R45E, Section 25, WM.**

**Being on or using road 312 west of the 312/1107 road junction in T35N R45E Section 24, WM.**

**Being on or using road 1107 and it's spurs west of the 1107/219 road junction in T35N R45E Section 14, WM.**

**Being on or using Trail 164 in T35N R45E, WM.**

**Being on or using Trail 197 in T35N R45E, WM.**

**When provided in an order, 36 CFR 261.54 (e) and 36 CFR 261.55 (a), it is prohibited to go into or be upon any area (road and trail) which is closed for the protection of public health or safety.**

This closure is necessary for public safety due to recent wildfire activity. This closure becomes effective on Monday, October 26, 2015 and will remain in effect until rescinded or revoked.

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.53(e) the following individuals are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or Local Law Enforcement Officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

**These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.**

**Violations of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both (16 U.S.C. 551 and 18 U.S.C. 3559 and 3571).**

**Road 305** – At private land boundary at Section 27/34 westward to Colville NF boundary

**Road 659** – At junction with Road 1108 westward to Colville NF boundary


**Road 1089 and spurs** – At junction with Road 659. Entire road system is closed.

**Road 1075 and spurs** – At junction with Road 312. Entire road system is closed.

**Road 312** – At junction with Road 1107 westward to Colville NF boundary. Includes 1076 road system.

**Road 1107 and spurs** – At junction with Road 219 westward to Colville NF boundary

**Trails 197 and 164** – Entire length of both trails are closed.
